The BYU Alumni Board of Directors has established the
BYU Alumni Community Service Award.

Community Service Award Criteria

Recipients of the award are nominated by BYU Alumni Chapters (or by the awards committee of the board for areas not organized into chapters) and approved by BYU Alumni.

It is anticipated that alumni chapters will submit nominees only when they have observed extraordinary service rather than annually. Each award should be presented at an event sponsored locally by the alumni chapter with appropriate community leaders in attendance.

Criteria for the nominations and selection of award recipients include the following:

1. Each nominee must:
 - a. be a member of the BYU Alumni Association as defined by the constitution and bylaws of the BYU Alumni Association,
 - b. be currently observing high standards of personal conduct, and
 - c. be cleared before receipt of the award by his or her stake president (applies only to alumni who are LDS).
 2. The nominee should have provided an unusually high level of service which has greatly benefited members of his or her community or state through devotion to moral, spiritual, professional, academic or artistic endeavors. Such service or contribution must have been of such a nature and over such a period of time as to suggest that the image and reputation of Brigham Young University would be enhanced by the public's recognition of the nominee as an alumnus.
